Charlo School District STUDENTS Release of Student During School Day Prior to sending a student home for illness, discipline, or a corrective action, the principal will attempt to reach the student's parent to inform the parent of the school's action and to request that the parent come to the school for the child. If the principal cannot reach the parent, the student will remain at school until the close of the school day. A student may be released to a law enforcement officer. Sending students on errands during school hours should be done only on necessary school business and with express permission of the principal.
